1.0 Purpose:

- 1.1 To provide the medical first responders (MFR) with standardized re-registration and refresher training programs.

2.0 Procedure:

- 2.1 Re-registration process for MFR Basic, MFR Advanced, and MFR Paramedic:
- 2.1.1 **MFR Basic** may recertify by completing a two-day standard first aid course with CPR through one of the recognized training agencies: i.e. St. John Ambulance or Canadian Red Cross. After which, they must complete additional bridging sessions that are provided by MFR Services.
- 2.1.2 **MFR Advanced** may complete MFR recertification training through one of the recognized training agencies: i.e. St. John Ambulance or Canadian Red Cross.
- 2.1.3 **MFR Paramedic** must provide proof that they are licensed with Nova Scotia Collage of Paramedics. In addition, they must be an active member of an EHS sponsored agency.

OR

- 2.1.4 **MFR Basic** and **MFR Advanced** may also recertify after meeting the criteria below:
- 2.1.4.1 Attend each of the six essential competencies training sessions facilitated by EHS MFR paramedic facilitators.
- 2.1.4.2 All six essential competencies sessions must be completed within the three year registration period.
- 2.1.4.3 The mandatory refresher training topics are identified in the Program Document No. 12014.00 (Essential Competencies MFR) and attendance is tracked by MFR Services.



- 2.2 EHS MFRs affiliated with Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency Service may attend in-house refresher training sessions as approved by the EHS Provincial Medical Director. Upon successful completion, supporting documentation of training (i.e. certificate of attendance) and registration form must be submitted prior to the expiration date on his/her current EHS MFR tag. All training must be provided by EHS approved Halifax Regional Fire & Emergency Service personnel.
- 2.3 A medical first responder that meets the criteria for reregistration may apply for their new EHS MFR tag by completing the *“Medical First Responder Registration/ Re-registration Application”* online form at www.ehsmfr.ca

MFRs may be required to provide proof of attendance of any refresher training sessions upon request.
